

Procedure for Securing Accommodation in the Halls of Residence (2020/2021 Academic Session)

Dear UI Undergraduate,

The following is the procedure for obtaining accommodation in the undergraduate Halls of Residence (HoRs) during the 2020/2021 Session. **Please note that accommodation will be offered on a first-come-first-serve basis.**

1. Assignment of Fresh Students to HoRs (3May, 2021)

ITeMs will publish the Hall affiliation of fresh students, who had not been assigned to HoRs.

2. Expression of Interest (31 May to 2 June, 2021)

Eligible students will be asked to express interest in securing accommodation. Kindly confirm your eligibility from the criteria provided. Also please note that the period for the expression of interest may be abridged once the quota for each category of students is filled. The following are the categories of student eligible for accommodation in the 2020/2021 academic session:

Those Eligible for Accommodation

- i. 100 level students.
- ii. Final year students.
- iii. Physically challenged/Health students.
- iv. 300 level preclinical students.
- v. Nursing students due for professional examinations.
- vi. Veterinary medicine students due for professional examinations.

3. Payment of Accommodation Fees (3-6 June, 2021)

Those who successfully expressed interest will be offered provisional accommodation, and required to pay.

4. Access to HoRs

The HoRs will open to students as soon as the University Senate Decides. **This provisional accommodation will only be confirmed upon the completion of registration with the University Health Services.** This should be done before the commencement of the second semester.

5. Other Requirements for residing in the HoRs

- i. Each resident of the HoR is required to wear a face mask when outside his or her room. Every resident is required to provide his or her personal COVID protective items, such as face masks and sanitisers.

- ii. Residents are required to wash hands frequently, but certainly upon returning to the HoR.
- iii. At least till the end of the first semester, only Hall residents will be permitted in the HoRs.
- iv. The HoRs will run at 50% capacity and “squatting” is highly prohibited.
- v. Third-time infractions of COVID preventive requirements will attract ejection from the HoR.
